Marina Rules and Regulations

1. The International Rules & Regulations for the Prevention of Collision at Sea apply in BVI waters.
2. All vessels entering the Marina must be cleared in with, or have been granted permission to land by BVI Customs and Immigration.
3. Vessels may not be berthed or anchored in any place other than what is allocated by NCRM Ltd from time to time. They may not be careened, have their bottoms cleaned and their bilges may not be discharged in the Marina without NCRM Ltd's express permission. All jetties are to be kept free from obstruction at all times.
4. Vessels must be kept in good condition. NCRM Ltd may inspect, move or re-secure them without notice and carry out, in the owner's absence, emergency repairs to bilge pumps, leaks, dock lines, etc, at the owner's expense. This includes Named Storm Preparation during the defined season.
5. No advertising or soliciting for business is permitted on any vessel except by prior arrangement with NCRM Ltd.
6. Children and Pets are to be kept under proper control at all times.
7. Heads must not be used in harbour.
8. No generators are to be run between 7pm and 7am except by prior arrangement with NCRM Ltd. Loose halyards are to be secured whilst in harbour.
9. No fishing, diving or swimming is permitted.
10. The speed limit in harbour is 5 knots. No wake to be generated.
11. No motors (including outboard motors on dinghies) should be operated between 10:00 pm and 7:00 am.
12. Subleasing of dock space is not permitted.
13. Laundry is not to be hung on boats or jetties.
14. No charcoal barbecue or other open fuel appliances to be used while in harbour, without the dock-master's permission.
15. Musical instruments, VHF radios, stereo equipment and other electronic equipment must not be played at all between the hours of 10:30pm and 6:00am and at other times only at low volume and below decks.
16. No shouting or singing in the marina area.
17. All accounts are to be settled before leaving. Owners for their own convenience should leave a forwarding address for mail.
18. No personal property or vessel's equipment are to be placed on docks or finger piers, other than with the written permission of NCRM Ltd. Any such equipment or property shall be removed and impounded by NCRM Ltd and only released when ownership is proved and costs of impounding paid.
19. In the event of a fuel spillage from your vessel or another in the marina, the Marina Office should be informed as soon as possible so that clean up measures can be put in place.
20. If in need of water you may contact the Marina Office to have the Dock-hands unlock and take meter readings before and after use.
21. Absolutely no boat trash is to be left on the dock and / or marina property. The harbour and

marina are to be left litter free at all times. Trash receptacles will be provided by NCRM Ltd in designated locations. Small bags of trash may be put in dockside receptacles; larger bags to be put in a dumpster. Dock carts are provided to aid this.

22. Violation of these rules, disorderly, indecorous or criminal conduct by an owner, his crew or guests on his vessel that is likely to cause injury, damage or loss of reputation to the marina will entitle NCRM Ltd to terminate a vessel's stay at Nanny Cay.
